



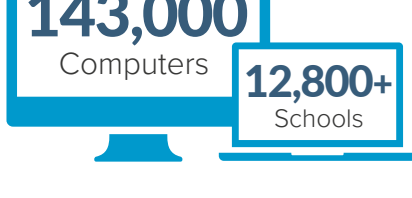

We have installed more than 143,000 computers in over 12,800 schools. We estimate that these have impacted well over 4.8 million children.

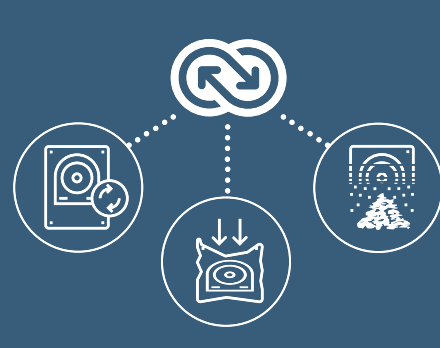

Vyta's Data Sanitisation & Reporting

Vyta has over two decades of experience in the secure disposal of redundant IT assets and have destroyed or wiped over 1 million drives to date.

Data Sanitisation

Vyta operate using Blancco's National Cyber Security Centre (NCSC) approved erasure software. Wiped drives can be reused by Camara, minimising any environmental impact and helping to provide African children with digital learning.

Physical Destruction of Hard Drives

Vyta offers a range of physical destruction techniques that can be carried out either on-site or off-site, to suit your security requirements.

Asset Reporting & Certification

Audit reports will display: asset serial, customer asset tag, manufacturer, model, hard drive serials, final disposition status and more. You will also receive a Certificate of Destruction for each wiped or shredded device, certifying that the data has been permanently destroyed.

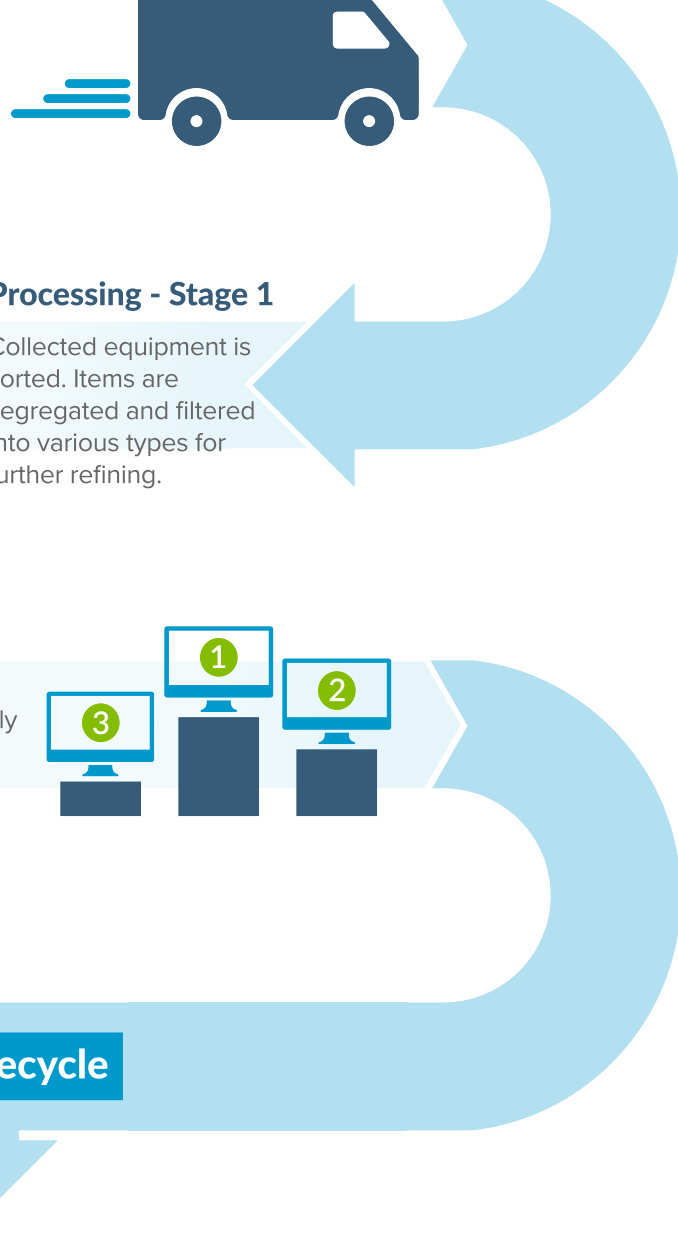

Direct Donation

Some of your assets will be ideal to reuse in classrooms with Camara.

We carefully prepare computers and other devices for schools, preloading them with educational content before shipping them to our partners in Ethiopia, Kenya, Tanzania, and Zambia.

Revenue Generation

For assets that are not suitable for reuse in schools, we resell them to generate revenue for the charity. This revenue is then used to purchase equipment that meets the specific needs of our computer labs. This approach allows us to accept a wider range of assets for donation, maximising the impact of your contribution

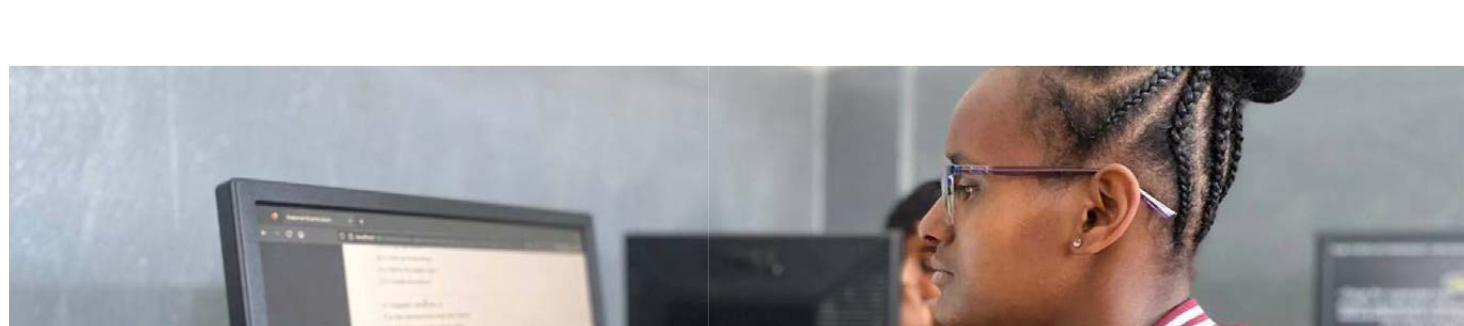
